COOKIES INFORMATION

Cookies are small text strings that the sites visited by the user send to his terminal (usually the browser), where they are stored before being re-transmitted to the same sites at the next visit of the same user. Cookies, usually present in users' browsers in very large numbers and sometimes even with long temporal persistence characteristics, are used for different purposes: execution of computer authentication, monitoring of sessions, storage of information on specific configurations concerning users accessing the server, etc.

This site collects "technical" cookies, which are those used for the sole purpose of transmitting a communication over an electronic communications network, or as strictly necessary for the provider of an information society service explicitly requested by the subscriber or by the user to provide this service. They are not used for further purposes and can be:

- navigation or session cookies, which guarantee the normal navigation and use of the website (allowing, for example, to authenticate to access restricted areas);

- analytics cookies, similar to technical cookies when used directly by the site operator to collect information, in aggregate form, on the number of users and how they visit the site;

- functional cookies, which allow the user to navigate according to a series of selected criteria (for example, the language) in order to improve the service rendered to the same.

While visiting our site, the computer systems in charge of the operation of the same acquire, during their normal operation, some data whose transmission is implicit and necessary for the operation of the Internet. This is information that is not collected to be associated with identified individuals, but which by their very nature could, through processing and association with data held by third parties, allow users to be identified. This category of data includes, for example, IP addresses or domain names of the computers used by users connecting to the sites, the addresses in Uniform Resource Identifier (URI) of the requested resources, the time of the request, the method used in submitting the request to the server, the size of the file obtained in response, the numerical code indicating the status of the response given by the server (success, error, etc.) and other parameters related to the operating system and the computer environment of the user. This site uses these data for the sole purpose of obtaining anonymous statistical information on the use of the sites and to check their correct functioning. The data could be used to ascertain responsibility in case of hypothetical computer crimes.

This site also collects the so-called "profiling cookies", ie those that allow the storage of information in the terminal device of a contractor or a user or access to information already stored.

These cookies are designed to create profiles related to the user and used to send advertising messages in line with the preferences expressed by the user in the context of navigation.

Promotional cookies are used to collect information about your browsing habits with the aim of offering advertising messages relevant to you and your interests. These cookies also allow us, while browsing other sites, to display for promotional purposes content that you have recently consulted on our site.

The promotional cookies we use are permanent, although they remain on your device for a limited time.

The data acquired during navigation may be known by the third-party companies that provide us with computer assistance and data processing services appointed for this purpose Data Processing Managers. The data can then be known and treated within our company by the personnel assigned to the processing in the limits in which this is necessary for the performance of their duties, performing only the operations necessary for the execution of the same. In case of express request and in the circumstances authorized by law, the data can be communicated to the Public Security Authorities and to the Police forces. No navigation data is in any way disseminated.

Do you want to refuse consent to the installation of cookies? Most browsers (Chrome, Firefox, Internet Explorer, Safari, etc.) are set to accept cookies automatically. However, you have the possibility to set your browser to accept all cookies, only some, or reject them, disabling their use by this or other sites. You can also set your browser's preferences to be notified whenever a cookie is stored on your computer. Furthermore, at the end of each browsing session, you can delete the collected cookies from the hard disk of your device. If you want to delete the cookies installed in the cookie folder of the browser used, know that each browser has different procedures for managing settings.

To disable and manage cookies, access your browser settings (in most cases click on the "help" menu and find the instructions for deactivating cookies or you can find them using the "search" function) and modify them according to your needs. However, please note that the absolute denial of the use of cookies may prevent you from using the services of different sites, including this, and make purchases, transactions, registrations and online access.
